"Now it is required that those have been given a trust must prove faithful." (1Cor.4:2)

We are told again and again how blessed we are that God loves us, that the Christ lived among us, died for us, and overcame sin for us. And while we often read in biblical texts that such love is received with responsibility as well, I suspect we all have a tendency to focus on the gift and not the giving.

Now, I am not talking about tithing or sharing or good works, exactly here, although they all eventually come into play; rather, I am referring again to the simple act of faith and faithfulness to our Creator who cares so deeply, to Jesus who walked so humbly, and to the generosity and *presence of* the Holy Spirit.

Paul, in this passage, is reminding the early church in Corinth not to be divisive know-italls! Reminding the early church, already negotiating for power, to be faithful to the one and only foundation, which is Jesus Christ. To be patient and unafraid in their faithfulness for the Christ will bring all that is right to light. It is easy to relate to this passage, because the world is relentless in its desire to judge, manipulate and punish and unfortunately it is all too often the church itself, of whatever Denomination, that provides scenarios seemingly unaware of Jesus' life or the concept of Grace. Paul was talking directly to anyone who would miss the point that power and divisiveness corrupt, and the simple truth must prevail. Thus, the requirement that the trust we have been given to share the Good News 'requires' faithfulness is not a punishing threat, but should be interpreted as a liberating, natural outpouring of our hope and joy. We should judge nothing, for Christ alone, God alone, will judge.

In this New Year, wouldn't it be terrific if we all stopped judging? If we stopped the namecalling and fear mongering and exchanged it for positive relationships and life-building engagement? What if we took Paul's words to heart and visualized Jesus, walking unafraid into life, challenging a broken status quo and transforming through love? I believe we can do this! That we, as Palm Springs Presbyterian Church, a bunch of very different personalities on the one hand, and bound together by our love of Christ on the other, can consciously, purposefully and joyfully accept the trust we have been given and faithfully engage our faith in a way that is, well, *faithful*.

As we approach our annual Congregational Meeting, I encourage each of us to prayerfully and personally consider the trust we have been given, to be leaders in building the *good* that is the church of Christ, which is in its essence the telling, sharing, demonstrating in word and deed, the *life* of Jesus. Are we faithful? Can we be more so? Who are we, and who can we be, to our community and to one another?

We are salt and light! Let's diminish the negative and accentuate the positive, love relentlessly and create fearlessly a place where all God's people will find a home of hope and welcome.
